Homemade Watercraft Bill of Sale

Please select the reason for the transfer of this watercraft:

- ☐ 1. The person who built the boat has passed away, and the family needs to sell it.
- ☐ 2. I (the seller) built the boat and no longer have a practical use for it.
- ☐ 3. I (the seller) built the boat and have owned it for over ten years; I would now like to replace it with another boat.

In accordance with one of the choices above, the Coast Guard will allow the sale of a homemade watercraft, provided that all safety requirements have been met according to 33 CFR Part 183. The owner must submit a report from a certified marine surveyor demonstrating compliance with these safety regulations. This report must be prepared by a third-party certified inspector, such as a member of the National Association of Marine Surveyors (NAMS) or the Society of Accredited Marine Surveyors (SAMS).

To locate a surveyor near you, visit:

Marine Surveyor Locator (<https://www.marinesurvey.org/>) and select "Yacht/Small Craft," then enter your zip code. The report must include a statement confirming, to the best of the inspector's knowledge, that compliance with federal regulations has been met. The cost of the survey report will be the responsibility of the owner.
