At the top of every boating safety checklist is one must-have item: **a life jacket**. These are required by law for every person on every kind of watercraft. So, get vested in fun and rock the float.



Motorboat

- ✓ Life jacket for each person on board; options include an orange vest, waist belt inflatables, ski style or traditional inflatable vest.
- ✓ Fire extinguisher
- ✓ First aid kit
- ✓ Noise producing device like a whistle or air horn
- ✓ Throwable flotation device, such as a ring buoy or square cushion with handles
- ✓ Registration decals displayed

Paddleboard

- ✓ Life jacket, readily accessible for each occupant; styles that allow for more upper body and arm mobility are popular
- ✓ Leash, quick-release is often preferred



Non-motorized

- ✓ Life jacket, readily accessible for each occupant; styles that allow for more upper body and arm mobility are popular
